- Each presenter will be given a total of 6 minutes ~4 minutes for presenting the case and 2 minutes for answering the questions from judges and audience.

- Speaker will be given 3 minutes to speak, followed by 1 minute of rebuttal. 30 seconds for cross questioning if necessary.

- Each team should select a medically relevant research topic and complete literature review, study design, data collection and analysis
- The abstracts should comprise of a maximum of 1500 words (from title to references) to be mailed to symposium@kritikmc.com before 9 am on 15th September. Selected abstracts will be revealed on 30th September.
- Each team must prepare an audiovisual presentation of their research together with script for the speakers who will be given a total of 15 minutes (10 minutes for the presentation, 5 minutes for the Q and A round).
- Rules regarding the content of the abstracts, criteria for the abstract, and screening will be conveyed to the participants in detail later.
